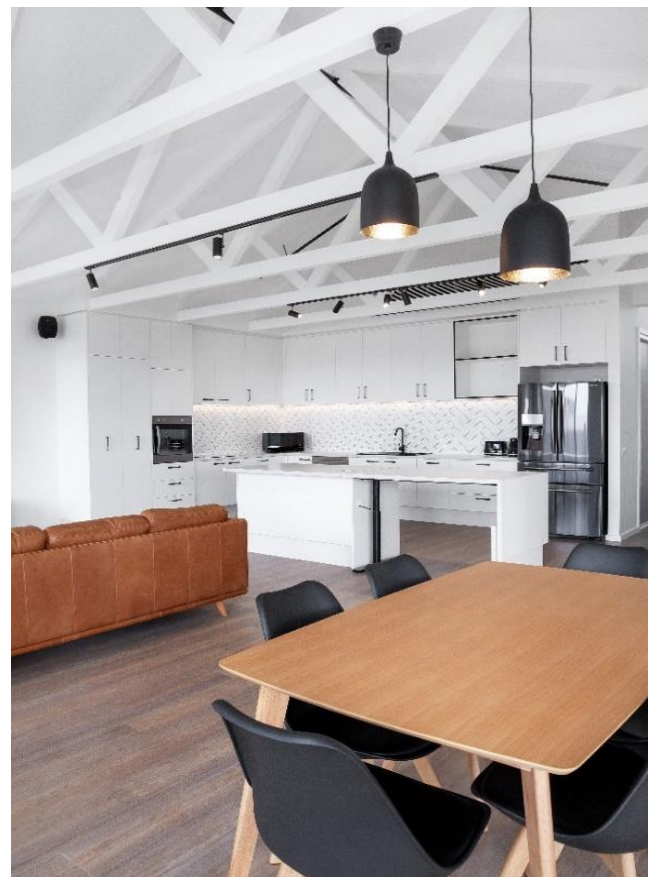
Their recently built Ballarat home provides three full-time residents with a level of disability support they would never have dreamt possible. It features numerous advanced technologies to enhance their quality of life, such as smart lighting and blinds that can be operated via handheld devices and voice activation. It also includes tracking and hoist systems that help residents move around the house.

“This house was built to the highest disability standard under the Australian Livable Housing Guidelines and will enable our residents to flourish in a supported model of living”, said McCallum’s CEO Tyrone McCuskey.

“We’re extremely proud to be able to provide a home of this standard, that is modern, built to enable and provide high levels of care to people with disability. We’re hopeful that this is the first of many new 10 star builds for McCallum in the coming years,” he said.
